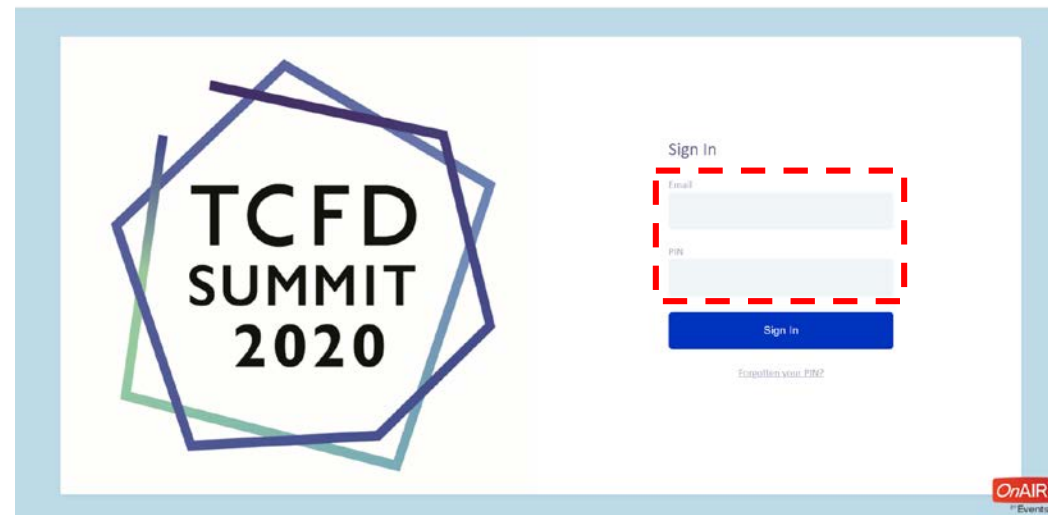

1. Email from Registration Desk

- ◆ You will receive an email from the registration desk **on October 9th in the morning (JST)** which includes the URL, ID and PIN for you to login to the online portal.

2. Login to Portal

- ◆ Please type in your ID and PIN which was sent to you via email.



- ① Please click on the "INFO" button at the top right hand corner of the page for a detailed instruction, including trouble shooting.
- ② When time comes, please choose the language "ORIGINAL", "JAPANESE" or "ENGLISH", click and join the session.
- ③ You can see the session's information by clicking the session title.
- ④ If you face any problems while watching the program, please contact the "Help Desk", which is on the top right hand corner of the screen.
